Program Process



This is the generalised process for the operation of the RSPCA Approved Farming Scheme Chain of Custody Program.

At each stage, the RSPCA Certification Body will liaise with participants to discuss and assist with their progression through the process. Our aim is to ensure effective verification of your conformance with the Chain of Custody Standard. The process is not intended to be onerous, however, your initial assessment is likely to require more liaison and information sharing than subsequent assessments. An assessment of your conformance with the Standard will be conducted annually. Following each successful assessment, a notice will be issued that confirms your business is part of the supply chain of RSPCA Approved products and has successfully demonstrated conformance with the requirements of the Chain of Custody Standard. Note that the RSPCA Certification Body may schedule on-site assessments to verify conformance with the Chain of Custody Standard at any time.



4 Submission of Materials

Applicants or existing participants must complete all forms, supply all required information (or verify information previously collected in the case of existing participants), and submit supporting documents as necessary

Certification Body Evaluation of Conformance

The RSPCA Certification Body will review submitted materials and liaise as necessary to clarify and verify information submitted; this may include the request for the submission of further documents

Confirmation of Participation

If conformance is determined, the RSPCA Certification Body will provide formal notice to the applicant / existing participant

Key Components



Supply

Products must be sourced from RSPCA Approved Producers Labelling

RSPCA Approved products must always be clearly identifiable

Segregation

RSPCA Approved products must be separated and distinguishable from non-RSPCA Approved products

Traceability

The volume of RSPCA Approved products must be recorded and traceable through all stages of handling **Management System**

Management systems must ensure the requirements of the Chain of Custody Program are met
